Care and Maintenance of your New Lawn Care Product

Thank you for purchasing your new product from Woolgoolga Mowers. We will be here to assist you throughout the life of your new product, but you can also help yourself get the longest life and trouble free operation from your new equipment.

Here's how:

- Keep your equipment clean. Yes, it's a tool and is designed for hard and dirty work, but giving it a clean after use is by far the most effective way of increasing the useful life of the product and ensuring trouble free operation. All products, EXCEPT ELECTRIC PRODUCTS, can be given a light hose down after use, BUT THE ENGINE **MUST** BE COOL TO TOUCH FIRST!!! Lawnmowers may be left running while you do this. Once done, leave them out in the sun to dry.
- Store your equipment in a place where it will not be damaged. A Line Trimmer in otherwise perfect condition is no use to anyone if something has fallen on it and bent the shaft.
- ALWAYS USE THE CORRECT FUEL! DO NOT USE ETHANOL BLENDED FUELS IN ANY OUTDOOR POWER PRODUCTS! Your instruction manual will tell you the type of fuel to use. TWO STROKE engines also require you to add a certain amount of oil to the fuel, while FOUR STROKE engines will run on straight fuel. Always check your instruction manual before adding fuel and if you accidentally fill with the wrong fuel DO NOT START THE MACHINE! Call us on the number above and we'll advise you what to do.
- Ensure you have your equipment regularly maintained. **Your first service is free** (just pay for the parts used) and we can advise you on how often you should have the equipment serviced after that. Your instruction manual should also have advice on this matter. Regular maintenance will save you money in the long run, as it will extend the life of the product.
